40+ Apps to start the Android journey on a new phone

Did you just buy a new Android phone? Don't know where to start your Android journey. Or if you just want to get tips on cool apps to try on your phone, check out this list of 40+ apps available for FREE.

> Special Tip: If you were an iPhone owner earlier than you will find that most apps (if not all) you used on iPhone are available for Android too.

Below is a list of 40+ Android apps that you should install right after buying any Android phone:

1. Social Networking Apps

When it comes to Social networking everyone has their favorites. But I am sure most people use Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn and Google+. So start by installing these apps in Social networking category:

- 1. Facebook for Android (<u>Link to Google Play</u>)
- 2. Twitter for Android (<u>Link to Google Play</u>)
- 3. LinkedIn (Link to Google Play)
- 4. Google+ (<u>Link to Google Play</u>)



Some people like to use All-in-one kind of apps like Tweetdeck, Hootsuite and Seesmic etc. But I personally prefer the native apps.

2. Music Apps

Search in <u>Music category</u> in Android Market, you will find thousands of apps. But start with these high quality apps on your new device:

- 5. DoubleTwist (possibly with <u>Airsync</u>) (<u>Link to</u> <u>Google Play</u>) : DoubleTwist is a feature rich Music player for Android. DoubleTwist comes with a matching Desktop software that allows you to sync media with your computer like you used to do with iTunes. Also if you spend \$4.99 (which I think you should) for AirSync it adds features like wireless syncing with PC. Airsync also enable Airplay like feature on your Android phone and allows you to stream media to Xbox, PS3 and other DLNA enabled devices.
- 6. <u>Google Music</u> (<u>Link to Google Play</u>) : Google Music allows you to stream your music from anywhere. Google provides online space for over 20,000 songs. Upload your entire music library in the cloud and enjoy your own music anywhere and everywhere with your Android phone.
- 7. iHeartRadio (<u>Link to Google Play</u>) : This apps allows you to listen to local FM radio channels and you can also start listening for a particular artist.
- 8. Pandora (<u>Link to Google Play</u>) or <u>any of its</u> <u>alternatives</u>.
- 9. Soundhound (<u>Link to Google Play</u>) : Never ever waste time to recognize random songs, find out the song information quickly with this app.

3. Reader Apps

No, I am not just talking about eReaders but also everything that lets you consume online content on your phone such as news, blogs, books & magazines etc.

- 10. <u>Feedly</u> (<u>Link to Google Play</u>) : A must have app for all RSS readers. Very beautiful interface, swipe left/right to read articles. Check it out, I am sure you will love it.
- 11. Flipboard (Link to Google Play)



- 12. <u>News360</u> (<u>Link to Google Play</u>) : The only single app you will ever install on your Android phone because it consolidate news from various channels so that you don't read any news twice.
- 13. Google Currents (Link to Google Play)
- 14. Amazon Kindle (Link to Google Play)



You may also like to install any specific news channel you subscribe to such as The New York Times, CNN, Fox News and USA Today etc. They all seem to do deliver a consistent news experience.

4. Cool Games

Well, this is a very personal section to write about. It will be very biased to say what apps are good. So, install whatever games you like. But just to give you a quick start on games try:

Also, your phone should have come with some pre-installed games.

5. Productivity Apps

- 19. <u>Any.Do</u> (<u>Link to Google Play</u>) : A task management app that syncs with Google Tasks in a really beautiful interface.
- 20.Springpad (<u>Link to Google Play</u>) : An evernote like note taking app only better and FREE.



- 21. DGT GTD (<u>Link to Google Play</u>) : A feature rich GTD to do app that syncs with Toodledo (covered in detail here). Even though at this time the app is in Alpha and Beta stage, but still it works flawlessly.
- 22. Google Voice (Link to Google Play)
- 23. Text plus (<u>Link to Google Play</u>) : Never pay for text messages again. Install this app and say bye-bye to your network SMS plan. This app uses your data plan to send messages. And no, the other party need not have the same app.
- 24. Keyring (<u>Link to Google Play</u>) and <u>7 other</u> shopping related apps.

How to setup Simple, Convenient and Reliable Conference Calls for FREE – No strings attached?

Conference calls are very essential activities in any business. When more than two parties want to discuss on any topic, we need a conference call. This is one of the most important activity any size of business need on a daily basis.

Question: Should hosting conference calls be any hard then? ... Not at all.

Well, if it is a long process at your organization then you may want to look at the way you schedule conferences. Because it should not take more than few minutes to host a conference call.



FREECONFERENCE.com lets host vou conference call with up to 150 participants for FREE. Yes, you read it right, for FREE.

Up to 150 participants can join the conference call which should accommodate almost any size of business. Personally I have never attended a call

with these many participants. Up to 10 people is what most regular conferences need.

Anyway, whatever your need is, you can check out Freeconference.com and create an account for yourself.



How

FREECONFERENCE

works?

- Create an account by filling up a simple form to get started.
- As soon as your account is created, you are provided by a number and access code.
- This number and access code can be used to host an impromptu conference call whenever needed.
- Using the web interface, few extra details can be added and the meeting can be scheduled.
- By scheduling your meeting through web, the contact details can be added and the meeting invite is sent to all the participants. The invite has the call details, access code, time, subject and participants.
- **Pre-schedule** conferences: the participants are provided with a long-distance number with an access code to join the conference in their email invitation.
- **Random reservation less Conferences:** you will have to somehow provide your number and access code you got during registration to the participants. (That is only for impromptu meetings.)

• You may get 800 number for your conference and other premium features like desktop sharing and call recording by paying a small fees.

FreeConference Sync Features:

FreeConference has developed following tools to make this service even more convenient:

- It works with Evernote to make it easy to remember your conference call discussions, before, during and after the call. <u>Learn more about this feature here</u>.
- Share with your friends and followers on Facebook and Twitter whenever you conduct a web-scheduled or reservation less conference.
- Automatically sync scheduled conference information to your Google Calendar.

- If you use Outlook, download the Outlook Add-in to easily schedule conference calls right from Outlook.
- Have a smartphone Install <u>FreeConference</u> <u>smartphone apps</u> for iPhone, Android or Windows Phone 7 to start, schedule or join a conference with the apps. There are many other features these smartphone apps offer. (May be something I will highlight in a separate post.)

In my testing, I couldn't ask for more for FREE. None of my participants had any complaints as well. You may want to check out yourself and let us know in comments if you use any other service for this purpose and how much it cost you set up a conference call. I am planning to use it for all my conference needs.

How to control your computer from anywhere using any smartphone?

With TeamViewer app for smartphones (iPhone, iPad, Android phone and tablets), you can remotely control your computer for free from anywhere, anytime!

With TeamViewer app installed on your computer and the smartphones, you can easily provide technical support to colleagues, friends and family members when they have computer problems.

You can also use this app to access your own home computer to edit documents or use any particular software while you are on the road. (You need to obviously password protect



Other Features of TeamViewer in general are as follows:

- TeamViewer works for Windows, Mac and Linux.
- Conveniently control remote computers using the multi-touch gestures: left click, right click, drag & drop, scroll wheel, zoom on your phone or tablet.

Android overtakes Apple in Global Smartphone Market share

We all knew it was going to happen one day...and I guess, today is that day. Android Robot keeps taking big bites from Apple in the smartphone market share.

According to the news article published on CNN Money, Google's Android surged to a whopping 68% share of the global smartphone market last quarter. That's four times more than the 17% market share held by Apple, according to a Wednesday report from research firm IDC.



As per the report 105 million Android phones were shipped in the second quarter — more than double the number shipped at the same time last year.

New phone models and highly competitive prices from various Android phone manufacturers like Samsung, HTC and Motorola etc. adds the required catalyst to Android ecosystem. Meanwhile, Android and Apple together didn't leave much room for competitors like RIM (Research in Motion) and Nokia including Microsoft's Windows Phone OS.

Agreed that there are rumors that Apple iPhone 5 will be released sometime in September this year but overall there seems to be a lack of interest in buying iPhone devices among people. So many of my friends recently bought an Android phone as well. Some opinions I hear from people who own an iPhone now or used to own one are:

- iPhone is boring nothing new.
- Screen size is too small.
- No major change in Apple iOS over the last so many years makes it look old.
- Android offers better options when selecting a new phone on contract for 2 years.

Well, only time can tell if Apple will be able to gain the market share back from Android or if there will be new entrants in this ecosystem to hinder Android's growth. But for now Android is here to stay while giving a solid competition to Apple.

What's more, users can create an unlimited number of stations, as well as give tracks the Pandora like thumbs up/down to influence future music choices.

And the fact that this Radio feature is available for free to all users on mobile makes it a Pandora killer.

How to simply track any package on Android

Parcels is a simple package tracking application, which lets you keep track of all your packages in one place on your Android device. With the integrated Google Maps slider you can easily find out where your packages are. With Parcels you can track any package on Android from almost any carrier.

Parcels support almost all major carriers including Amazon, Apple, DHL, FedEx, UPS and USPS. Complete list of supported services are mentioned in Google Play description.

How does it work?

- Well, you just enter the tracking number manually or scan the bar code after installing the app on your android device. Parcels will start its magic and quickly find out where your package is.
- In the preferences you can activate background checking so that the app can update you about the latest status at regular intervals.
- Or you may check it manually by launching the app.
- As soon as the package is delivered, it stops tracking the package to conserve battery.

From sometime I was getting the following *Redemption Helper Outlook Extension error*. That was very annoying, whatever I do, it was coming back.

There is nothing to uninstall or anything like that. I searched for 3-4 days on the Internet but everywhere it explains the error but nowhere I could find the solution.



Finally today, I got the fix when I read error wordings and figured that it was something related to *Memeo AutoBackup*.

I searched for Memeo and on their forum this error was listed under 'Redemption.dll error'. It was nothing.



Some add-on which might have expired was creating this problem.

How did I solve the problem?

- 1. Open Outlook 2007.
- 2. Go to Tools ->Trust Center ->Add ins.
- 3. Select Manage -> Exchange Client Extensions, say Go.
- 4. It will open the Add-on Manager.
- 5. Deselect anything with Redemption.
- 6. Say OK.
- 7. Restart Outlook.
- 8. The annoying error is gone.
